June 13 to 17, 1-4PM, Dynamic Dinos (4-7 years old)



Want to look at Dinosaur teeth close up? Become a paleontologist and go on a Dinosaur Dig! You'll investigate the habits, needs, and characteristics of dinosaurs and explore the fossilization process in this fun, hands-on Mad Science camp. It's all about Dinosaurs!

June 27- July 1, 1-4PM, Rockin' Rockets & Aerodynamics (Ages 6-12)



From the earliest flying machines to the first rocket flights, this week long hands-on program will teach you how to build many different flying devices. See how Newton's Laws of motion help explain how things move, how rockets fly and show you how amazing our Milky Way is.

July 11-15, 1-4PM, Mad Science Spy Academy (Ages 5-12)



Mad Science Spy Academy will help you sharpen your special operative skills as you learn about the secret world of espionage. You'll step into the shoes of a detective—uncover the science involved in evidence gathering and analysis. Become a super sleuth and learn clever ways of performing tasks in this hands-on view of the science that spies use. From decoding messages to metal detectors and night vision, campers will have the opportunity to check out spy equipment, and discover the technological tools of detection! Identify and collect evidence, from fingerprints to tracks to trash! Recreate the scene of a crime using clues and detailed observations. Campers will use science to connect the dots and help sniff out the suspects in this hands-on investigation into the science of sleuthing



Tuesdays at 3-3:45PM – Ballet/Tap Dance Camp (ages 3-5)
